##### **Step 1:**

Open Safari.

Type in our portal address:

Use Password saver to ease use.





## Step 2:

Add your log in name here (not the abwsent) and enter your password. Also check “remember me”.

You may also select to add this entry to your PASSWORDS section in your Iphone—so you do not need enter this data each time.

Touch Log In.



## Step 5:

You should now be on the Opening/Home page of your account in the Shop-Sentry or Home-Sentry Portal.

Use the Drop-Down Menu to proceed within the Portal.

# PHONE CALL SET UP

## TO INSURE “RING THROUGH” 24 HOURS PER DAY

### **Step 1:**

Look in your phone calls “recent” section, find the phone call from your last ABW phone call—alerting you to an alert and add it as a “contact”.

Insert a name for this phone call number. Here we have used ABW ALERT NOTICE. You can use any name you want.


If you cannot find a recent phone call from ABW—you can use 385-245-2815, however, you may receive a different number in your area. If a different number is received, you will need to update or add that number to this contact record.



### **Step 2:**

Select “edit” and go to the ringtones below.

Touch the “ringtone” area so you can make choices.



### Step 3:

Select-turn on “Emergency Bypass”.

Select the Tone you would like to hear when you receive a call from the ABW Alert system. Many people select an “alarm or alert” type sound—so it stands out.




### Step 4:



## TO INSURE “RING THROUGH” 24 HOURS PER DAY


### **Step 1:**

Look in your phone calls “recent” section, find the phone a call from your last ABW phone call—alerting you to an alert and add it as a “contact”. Insert a name for this phone call number. Here we have used ABW ALERT NOTICE. You can use any name you want.

Go to “Settings”.


Select “Notifications”

Select “Do Not Disturb”.



Set up your desired “Do not Disturb” parameters as you desire.

Select “Calls & Messages”.





### Step 4:
